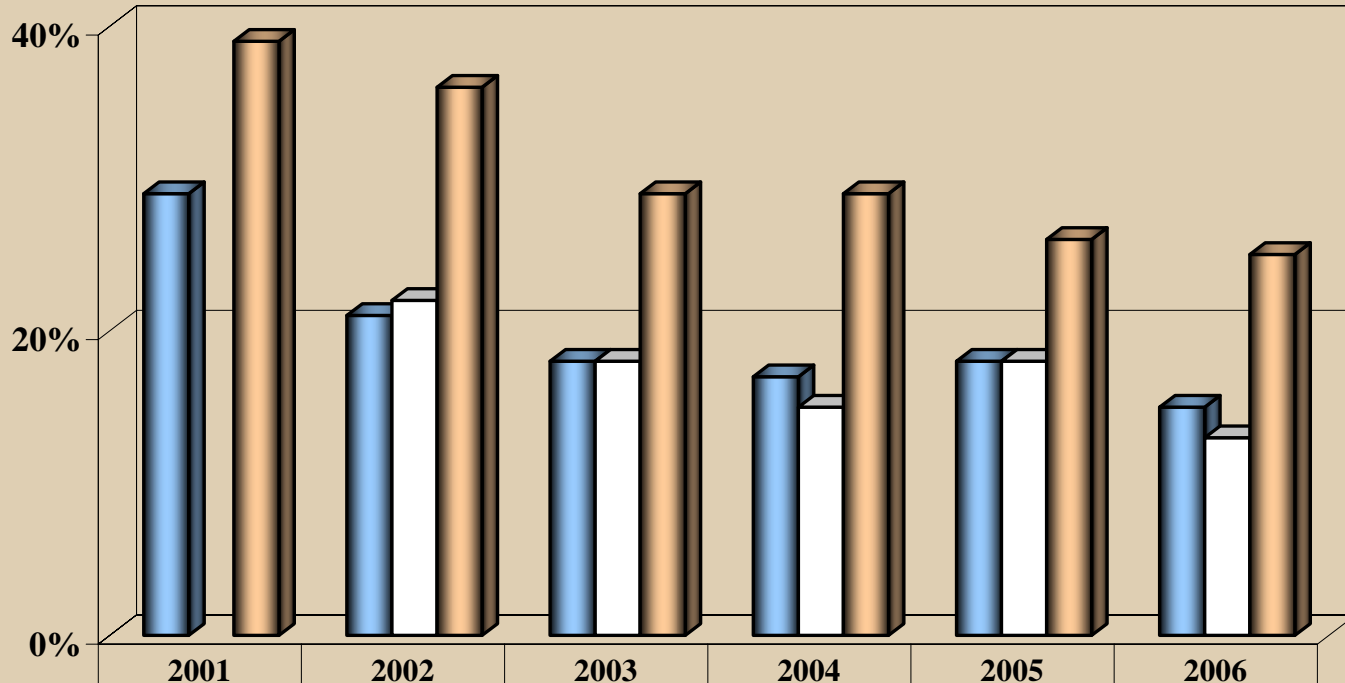

Child Attended Party Where Alcohol Was Served (yes, definitely or yes, probably)



■ All Parents	29%	21%	18%	17%	18%	15%
□ Matched Parents		22%	18%	15%	18%	13%
■ Matched Youth	39%	36%	29%	29%	26%	25%

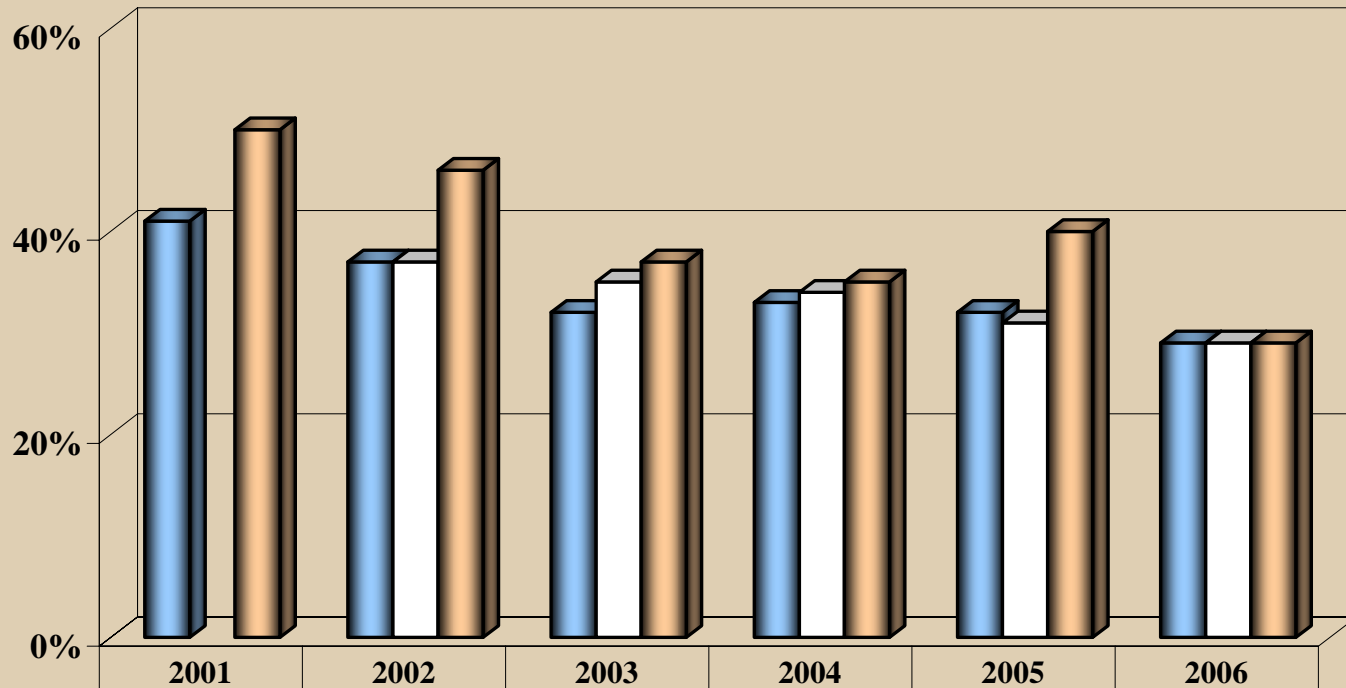
2001 - 2006 *Parents Who Host* Comparative Data

This represents a **36% decrease**
among youth who report they
have attended a party where
alcohol is available or served.



Know Of Parents Who Host Parties Where Alcohol Is Available To Teens

(yes, definitely or yes, probably)



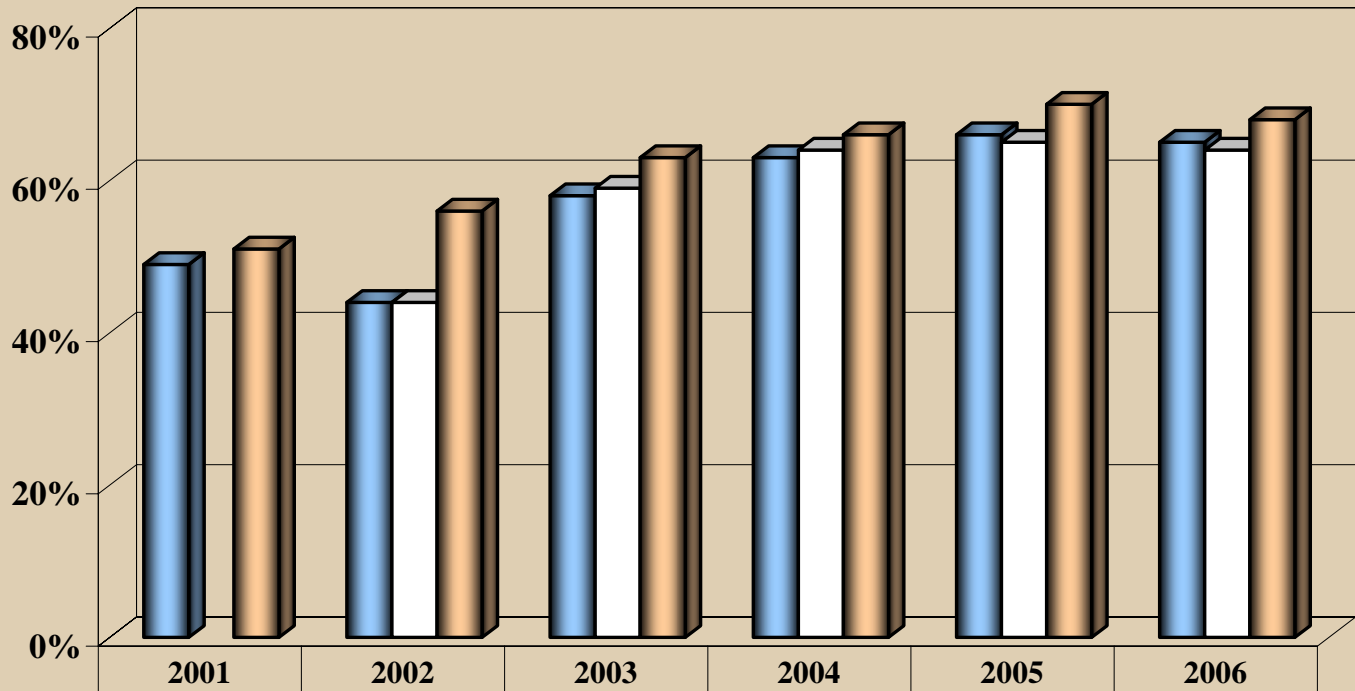

2001 - 2006 *Parents Who Host* Comparative Data

This represents a **42% decrease**
among youth & a **29% decrease**
among parents who indicate they
know of parents who host parties
where alcohol is available to
teens.

 (somewhat or strongly agree)



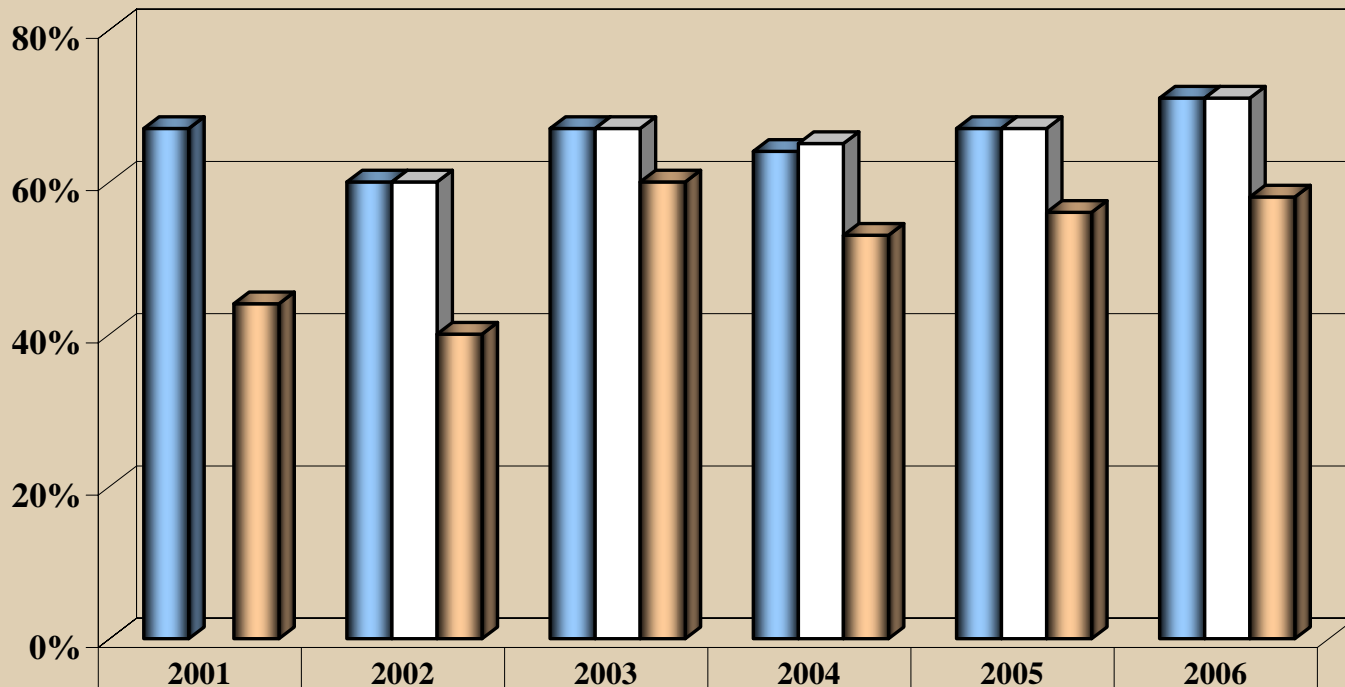

2001 - 2006 *Parents Who Host* Comparative Data

This represents a **33% increase** among parents who indicate that if parents knew this information, it would keep them from hosting teen parties where alcohol is available or served.



The Information Led To A Discussions About The Dangers Of Going To Parties Where Alcohol Is Served
(somewhat or strongly agree)

among youth who indicate that
